### **Application Instructions:**

There are different application instructions based on your student classification:

- 1. Current University Housing Resident: If you are interested in returning to the halls for 2024-25, you will need to complete your Notice of Intent in My UW Housing between October 18 and October 25. If you are allotted a room selection time, complete your language program application by October 25, and are accepted to the program, you will be able to select your room as soon as November 1/2, depending on your room selection timeslot. Students who submit an application after October 25 may still be eligible for a language program, but may not be able to select a space on the first selection days. - 2. Current UW-Madison Student, But NOT University Housing Resident: You must apply for both a University Housing contract AND for the 中文天地 program. - 3. New UW-Madison Student: You must receive a housing contract AND apply for the 中文天地 program. Housing contracts are sent based on the admission dates of students as long as space remains available. If you receive a housing contract, please submit your 中文天地 application no later than May 1, 2024
