I also understand that the main purpose of the Korean House program is to enable students to gain, maintain and improve fluency in the Korean language by using it as their primary means of communication with Korean House residents. I understand that the use of Korean is obligatory at all Korean House activities and events. I agree to participate fully in the cultural and social activities of the Korean House, including taking meals regularly with the other residents in the dining room. I understand that I am required to enroll in the one-credit Korean House course both semesters (information on enrolling for the fall will be sent during the summer), and that I may request permission for an exemption to this requirement only in the case of a course conflict or a conflict with another official university activity. I also understand that I must be enrolled in a level appropriate Korean-language course unless I receive an exemption by the Korean House Faculty Director.

Application Instructions:

There are different application instructions based on your student classification:

- 1. Current University Housing Resident:** If you are interested in returning to the halls for 2024-25, you will need to complete your Notice of Intent in My UW Housing between October 18 and October 25. If you are allotted a room selection time, complete your language program application by October 25, and are accepted to the program, you will be able to select your room as soon as November 1/2, depending on your room selection timeslot. Students who submit an application after October 25 may still be eligible for a language program, but may not be able to select a space on the first selection days. - 2. New UW-Madison Student:** You must receive a housing contract AND apply for the K-House program. Housing contracts are sent based on the admission dates of students as long as space remains available. If you receive a housing contract, please submit your K-House application no later than **May 1, 2024**.
