I agree to participate fully in the cultural and social activities of Norden program, including enrolling in the one-credit intlst 310 Norden language course (no prior Nordic language knowledge is required) and attending the bi-weekly lecture/meals regularly with the other residents in the dining room and at ILC Dinners totaling to an average of about 3 hours / week commitment.** I also understand that I am to be enrolled in a Nordic-language course of my skill level if I have had less than 2 years (or the equivalent) of formal language study if I intend to sign up for ScandSt 411.

- 3. New UW-Madison Student:** You must receive a housing contract AND complete the registration form for the Norden program. Housing contracts are sent based on the admission dates of students as long as space remains available. If you receive a housing a housing contract, please submit your Norden application no later than **May 1, 2021**.
