There are different instructions based on your student classification:

- 1. Current University Housing Resident: If you are interested in returning to the halls for 2022-23, you will need to complete your Notice of Intent in My UW Housing between October 27 and November 6. If you are allotted a room selection time, complete your language program application by November 6, and are accepted to the program, you will be able to select your room as soon as November 15/16, depending on your room selection timeslot. Students who submit an application after November 6 may still be eligible for a language program, but may not be able to select a space on the first selection days. - 2. New UW-Madison Student: You must receive a housing contract AND apply for the Norden program. Housing contracts are sent based on the admission dates of students as long as space remains available. If you receive a housing contract, please submit your Norden application no later than May 1,2023.
