

Reservations are being taken for accommodations in <u>Chadbourne Hall</u>, a University residence hall located at 420 North Park Street, Madison, WI 53706. Rooms are available as single occupancy, all with single/twin beds. Maximum occupancy is two persons per room. Chadbourne Hall will be open to receive guests beginning Saturday, July 13 at 12:00 p.m. and will be available until 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 25.

Sleeping Accommodations and Amenities:

- Bed linens, pillows, towels, washcloths, drinking cups, soap and other amenities are furnished.
- Free high-speed (wired and wireless) Internet and digital TV connections are available in the guest rooms for your electronic devices. Computer cables may be borrowed from the hall desk.
- All rooms are air-conditioned and have a small refrigerator, television and clock radio.
- Rooms will be cleaned, beds made and towels changed daily (except Sundays, July 14 and 21).
- Floor lounges provide large televisions and comfortable seating to relax and socialize. Coffee and tea service will be available on the first floor.
- Computers are available for use on the lower level.
- Laundry facilities, vending and ice machines are provided on the lower level.
- All facility areas are smoke-free, including guest rooms. Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not allowed within 25 feet of any University building or on dining terraces.
- No parking is available at the residence halls. Please refer to your program registration materials for information regarding parking arrangements.
- All guests must follow <u>Housing policy</u> and campus policies.

Bathrooms: Guest rooms do not have private bathrooms, so three single-gender bathrooms are located on each floor. These shared facilities include private shower and changing areas. Men and women will be assigned to separate bathrooms. We recommend that all guests bring a bathrobe, slippers/flip-flops and a case to carry personal items.

Desk Services: Chadbourne Hall is staffed with 24-hour desk service at the main entrance. Guests receiving calls should instruct family and friends to call 608-262-2688 during the conference. Messages will be placed in mailboxes near the hall desk as there are no in-room phones. Irons, ironing boards and recreational equipment are available for check-out on a first-come, first-served basis. Please return after each use, so other guests may use these items.

Meals/Rates: <u>Rheta's Market</u>, located on the first floor in Chadbourne Hall. Please look to your program schedule for meal locations and times. The payment for the package rate for most meals and the guest room are due to CUNA Management School by their deadline. Administrative considerations and the modest cost of accommodations and meals make it necessary for these rates to be offered only on a package basis. No refunds for missed meals or nights of lodging arranged in your package. Please bring the meal card issued at check-in to every meal in Rheta's.

Reservations: To make a reservation with University Housing, please complete the <u>online reservation</u> form. Each person staying in Chadbourne Residence Hall must make an online reservation before the deadline. **Reservations for residence hall accommodations are due by Friday, June 28, 2019.**

Cancellations: Cancellations can be made through Friday, July 5, 2019 (11:59 p.m. CST).

Parking: Residence halls do not have adjacent parking lots. Please refer to your program registration materials for information regarding parking arrangements. Please contact University Transportation Services at 608-262-8683 or <u>visitorparking@fpm.wisc.edu</u> prior to your arrival to reserve campus parking.
