## LAUNDRY ROOMS

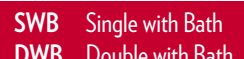
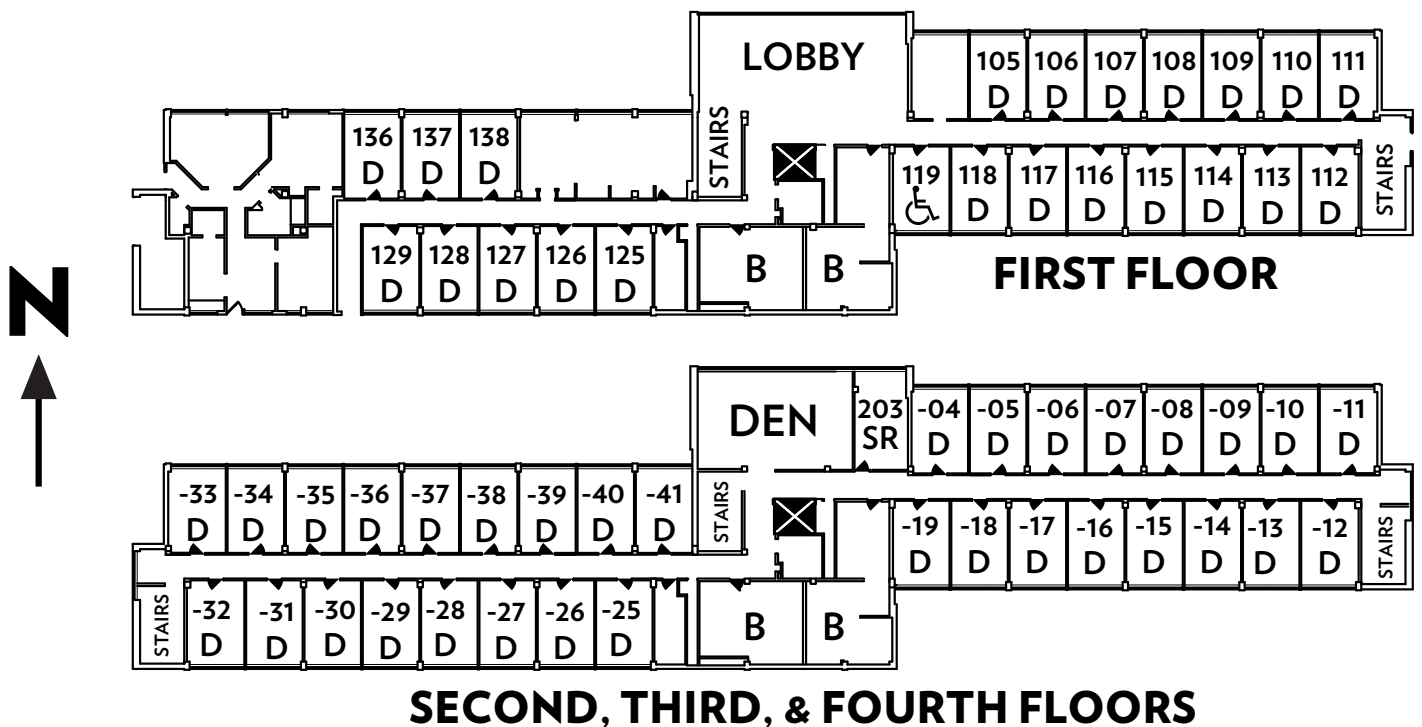
Laundry facilities are located in the lower level.

### COED BY WING (1<sup>st</sup> floor)

Women and men live on the same floor. However, there are divisions via features such as stairwells, elevators, lobbies, or hallway doors. There are separate bathrooms for men and women on each floor.

### MIXED COED FLOORS (second - fourth floors)
